Baby Room:

We've been very tactile this month — we touched different textures of fruit (apples, bananas, oranges), and some of the babies were able to point at and identify different fruits. We also made beautiful fruit baskets to take home.

We are pleased to announce that some of the babies have begun to crawl and even take a few steps!

Toddler Room:

Looking through food magazines, we've been able to explore and identify different types of food. The staff have been teaching the children how to say certain fruit & vegetables (e.g. milk, banana, pasta, rice). Children were encouraged to stick pictures of food they like on to their own paper plate. Please do feel free to look in the hallway, as there is a display board showing each child's favourite foods. We also made baskets of fruit from salt-dough: the children would paint and shape the dough in the same colour as a corresponding piece of fruit.

Nursery Room:

As you all know, on the 14th of February was Valentine's Day! We made cookies and cards to celebrate the occasion, all of which were to be taken home to be enjoyed by parents.

This month, we've been focusing on reading The Very Hungry Caterpillar and exploring similar themes in our story sack. At snack time, we also made caterpillars out of cucumbers & tomatoes! This month, we discussed what our favourite foods are: we explored "healthy eating" and enjoyed a variety of different plates of food.

Pre-School Room:

This month, we've not only been listening to stories, but also acting them out. Favourites include Goldilocks and The Three Little Pigs. We've also been reading non-fiction books about spiders, lions, and dinosaurs!

We've been working out socks off in phonics this month! Over Threes have been segmenting words into syllables and then writing down the sounds heard, and Under Threes have been clapping the syllables and linking sounds to letters, as well as practicing how to write their names.

We focused on the importance of healthy eating, and really put this in to practice – we took a fun trip to the market and made smoothies with the fruit we bought. Delicious!
